Our furniture puts values into practice, creating a physical piece of culture. Our tables and chairs make people feel comfortable – at work, in restaurants, in hotels and at home.



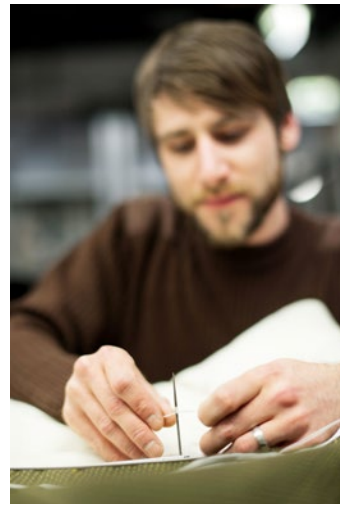

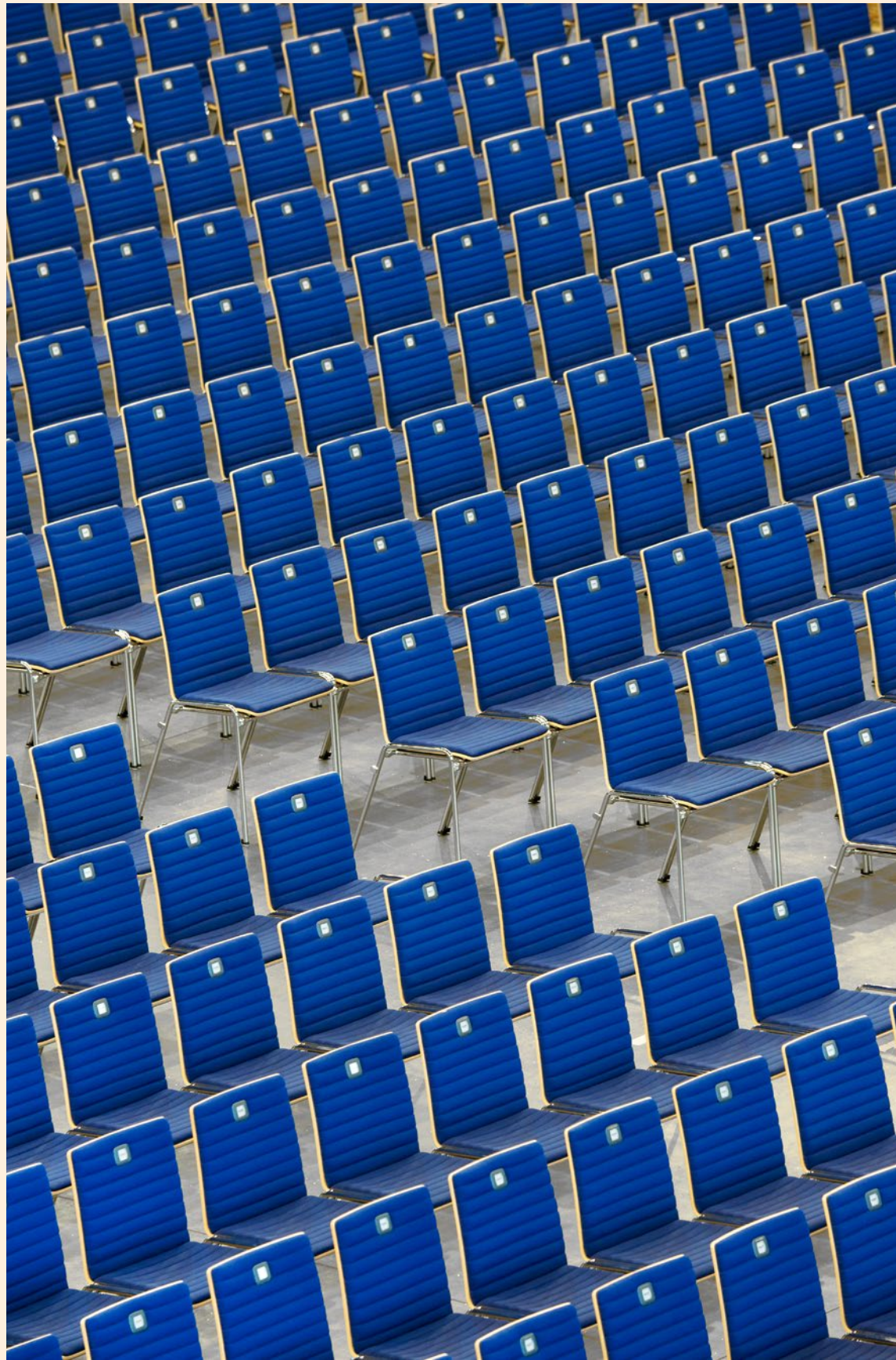

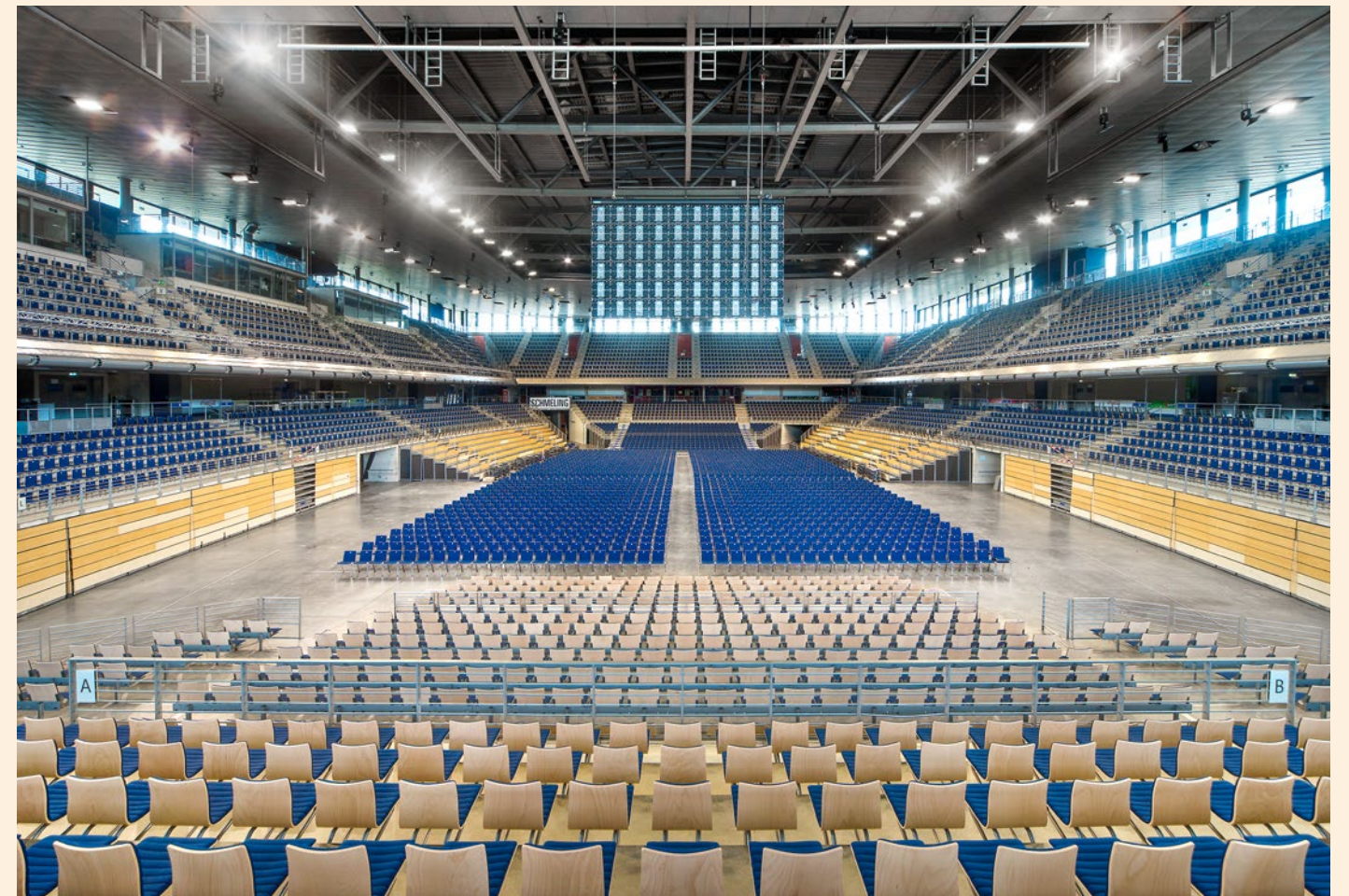
